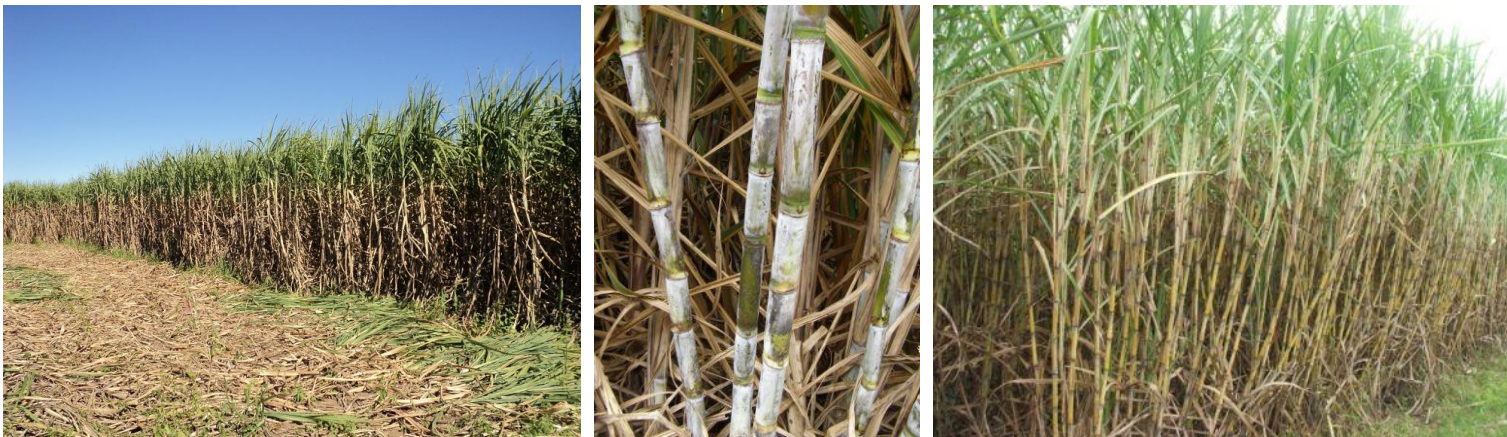

### **SUGARCANE**

Chief Steward: Mr M T Lewis

Stewards: Messrs GG Anderson, JW Anderson, SI Causley, D Causley, B Donaghy, HD Green, R Carr, PG Smith and PJ Castle.

Entry Fee \$2.00 including weight and CCS unless otherwise stated.

#### **NOTE:**

1. All entries must be entered in the name of the PAE holder from which it originates.
2. Points will be awarded to individual entries on the basis of 3 points for a win, 2 points for a second and 1 point for a third. The aggregate total of points for each exhibitor shall determine the winner of the competition.
3. Scale of points, awarded are as follows: weight of stalk, length and thickness of stalk, freedom of stalk from physical injuries and borer damage. All aerial and ground roots and side shoots should be removed together with any dirt or mud. Excessive scrubbing and polishing should be discouraged.
4. Exhibits can be entered in one class only.
5. No exhibitors shall make more than two entries in each class, except for Class 13 and 28.
6. Exhibits not to include suckers excepting class 13. This will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED**.
7. All exhibits **must be on the ground by 5:00pm on the day prior to the show** and class tickets are to be placed on each entry in the presence of a steward. This rule will be strictly adhered to.
8. Trophies and prize money have been donated by Manildra Harwood Sugars, the Clarence Cane Growers Association, Shannon Bros, Norco Co-operative Limited, McGregor Gourlay, O'Halloran Motors, NSW Agricultural Advisory Committee, Nutrien Ag Solutions, RDO Equipment, McLennan & Deece Optometrists and Grafton Toyota.
9. In the event of any dispute the decision of the stewards will be final.
10. Any prize money not collected from the Show Office will be available for collection at the Clarence Canegrowers Office.
