Entry Fee \$2.00 including weight and CCS unless otherwise stated.

NOTE:

1. All entries must be entered in the name of the PAE holder from which it originates.
2. Points will be awarded to individual entries on the basis of 3 points for a win, 2 points for a second and 1 point for a third. The aggregate total of points for each exhibitor shall determine the winner of the competition.
3. Scale of points, awarded are as follows: weight of stalk, length and thickness of stalk, freedom of stalk from physical injuries and borer damage. All aerial and ground roots and side shoots should be removed together with any dirt or mud. Excessive scrubbing and polishing should be discouraged.
4. Exhibits can be entered in one class only.
5. No exhibitors shall make more than two entries in each class, except for Class 12 and 28.
6. Exhibits not to include suckers excepting class 12. This will be **STRICTLY ENFORCED**.
7. All exhibits **must be on the ground by 5:00pm on the day prior to the show** and class tickets are to be placed on each entry in the presence of a steward. This rule will be strictly adhered to.
8. Trophies and prize money have been donated by Manildra Harwood Sugars, the Clarence Cane Growers Association, Shannon Bros, Commonwealth Bank, Norco Co-operative Limited, Wesfarmers Federation Insurance, O'Halloran Motors, NSW Agricultural Advisory Committee, BGA and Andrew Davison.
9. In the event of any dispute the decision of the stewards will be final.

8 stalks 2 year old cane of any variety in classes 1 to 11, to be properly topped, will be weighed and analysed and the product of the two results will determine the placings. A maximum of four entries from varieties will be allowed.

- 1st Prize Perpetual Shield donated by Clarence Cane Growers Association in addition to \$100 worth of product donated by BGA
- 2nd Prize Trophy and \$100 voucher donated by Shannon Bros
- 3rd Prize \$25

Special Prize for the highest CCS in the class (exhibit must weigh at least 22kg):

- 1st Prize CI Davison Memorial Trophy, plus \$25
- 2nd Prize \$10
- 3rd Prize \$5

- All exhibitors will go into the draw to win two tonnes of billets of their choice (pending availability) from the Harwood Approved Seed Plot (ASP).
- Best entry by new exhibitor (\$10).
- Most entries in this Section: 1st \$20, 2nd \$10, 3rd \$6.
- Special Prize of \$10 for entry in Class 28 that exceeds the record weight of 8 stalks (45.1kg=99.2lb, held by David Moloney, 2010).

- Champion 2 year old entry – prize donated by Norco
- Champion 1 year old entry - prize donated by Wesfarmers
- Champion Exhibit of Show (**Commonwealth Bank Shield**) & \$100 voucher donated by **O'Halloran Motors**.
