HORSE AND SPORTING EVENTS

- * **Camping Fees:** The charge for caravans or vehicles which are brought onto the ground and used for camping will be \$5 per day
- * **Post Entries for all Ring Events:** Coloured tickets to be purchased at the ring office. Entry tickets will be collected by stewards before judging of each event commences.
- * **Identification Cards:** Competitors are required to complete identification cards (available at ring office) for recording purposes by stewards.
- * **Prize Money:** to be collected on show days. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to collect, as no prize money will be posted. Any prize money unclaimed after 30 days shall be forfeited.
- * **Definition of a Maiden Horse:** is a hack, galloway or pony which has not won a first prize as such in their class at any recognised Agricultural Show.
- * **Definition of a Novice Horse:** is one that has not won an open champion at a recognised show or rodeo conducted by an Agricultural Society or a first prize at a Royal Show.
- * **In all Registered Classes:** registration papers/ membership must be produced upon the request of a steward. Registered horses and ponies cannot compete in unregistered classes unless otherwise stated.
- * **All Competitors compete at their own risk in accordance with the rules of the Society.** The committee will exercise reasonable care, but will not accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss sustained by any competitor or exhibitor.
- * **Junior Competitors:** must wear skull caps and their age shall be determined as of the first day of the show.
- * **All Protests:** must be accompanied by a fee of \$150 and in the event of the committee upholding the protest the fee will be refunded.
- * **Breakfast:** will be available on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings from 6am

Stallion Safe Practise Regulations

- * Stallions cannot compete with Geldings or Mares in Hack or Riding Classes.
- * Stallions should wear official "discs" at all times whilst on Maclean Showgrounds. These discs are to be worn on both sides of head collars and bridles or on some part of the horse on both sides to identify to others that the horse is a stallion.
- * No stallion is to be moved around Maclean Showground without displaying the stallion discs and a suitable restraint. The restraint can be a bridle, a rearing bit or a chain lead rein over the nose or under the jaw.
 - * Where possible all stallions are to be stabled. If suitable stabling is not available, stallions must wear a collar, which is securely tied to the outside of a truck or trailer. Stallions tied to the outside of a truck or trailer MUST be supervised at all times.
 - * Stallions must be substituted in prize-giving ceremonies with another horse should the rider deem it to be safer.
- * It is recommended that riders and handlers of stallions at shows be over the age of 17 years; however, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to understand the full code of conduct for stallions at events. With the exception of rule 1.1.8 in the Show Horse Rules and Guidelines, stallions are not permitted in show horse classes at EA State or Championship events. All riders/handlers under the age of 17 years must be supervised by an adult/parent/guardian whilst at the event.
- * It is the stallion riders/handlers responsibility to ensure that all possible safety precautions are taken.
- * Floats/trucks that transport stallions should display the official magnet giving notice that there is a stallion on board.
- * **Judges** may withhold any prize if they are of the opinion there is not sufficient merit to justify an award.
- * **The Committee reserves the right** to add or cancel any event in the schedule and reduce the prize money in the event of adverse weather or unforeseen circumstances causing a financial loss.
- * **The Committee reserves the right** to alter any clause, condition or event in this program.
- * **The Committee's decision** in all matters of dispute shall be final.
- * **Any dogs** brought onto the ground must be under strict control and will be the responsibility of the owner.

* **Livestock owners** are advised that they should carry their own Public Liability Insurance.

* **Stallions** cannot compete in riding and hack classes unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

* **Objectionable Conduct** . . . Any person who, in the opinion of the committee, shall cause annoyance by loud and unseemly comment upon the decision of a judge, or any official on duty, and any person whose conduct shall in the opinion of the disputes committee be guilty of unseemly, offensive or insulting behaviour may be expelled from the show ground, and shall, upon being requested by the committee to do so, forthwith vacate and leave the show ground or such part thereof as such officials shall direct.
